7. To receive notification from East Hampshire District Council of the following Temporary Street Barriers:-

- a) A rolling road closure starting at Petersfield Market Square, moving along Swan Street into Frenchmans Road round the Bell Hill Roundabout until the first exit into The Winchester Road, turning right into Beckham Lane to the Recreation Ground starting at 1830 hours and ending at 1900 hours for the occasion of The Petersfield Round Table Bonfire and Firework Display – 7th November 2009.
 - b) To close the A272 from the junction at the roundabout with the A3 to the junction at the Bell Hill roundabout allowing the public to disperse after leaving the Petersfield Round Table Firework Display between 1955 hours and 2025 hours – 7th November 2009.
8. To receive notification from East Hampshire District Council of an application for licensing of tables and chairs on the highway by Folly Wine Bare & Ale House.
 9. To receive notification from Hampshire County Council of the following temporary road closures:-
 - a) Station Road, Petersfield to allow Network Rail to carry out essential maintenance works on or adjacent to Station Road Petersfield level crossing from 16th October 2009 for a period of 18 months or until the works are completed whichever is the sooner. It is expected that the closure will only be required occasionally overnight between the hours of 2000 and 0600.
 - b) Kingsfersden lane, from 20m each side of the level crossing to allow Network Rail to carry out essential maintenance works, on or adjacent to Kingsfersden Lane Petersfield level crossing from 12th October 2009 for a period of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. It is expected that the closure will usually only be required occasionally overnight between the hours of 2200 and 0600.
 - c) School Lane, from 20m each side of the level crossing to allow Network Rail to carry out essential maintenance works on or adjacent to School Lane sheet level crossing from 12th October 2009 for a period of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. It is expected that the closure will usually only be required occasionally overnight between the hours of 2200 and 0600.
 10. To receive notification from East Hampshire District Council of licensing applications up to 25th September 2009.
