Members received and noted notification from East Hampshire District council of an appeal on application SDNP/30928/025 – Alterations and extensions to building to create 69 bedroomed hotel with restaurant, leisure, ceremony and functions suites and 16 dwellings within walled garden’ landscape restoration, management plan and new traffic junction – variation of condition 28 of 30928/022 to allow occupation of the approved dwellings prior to the commencement of a hotel use with a minimum of 22 bedrooms (as opposed to 40) – Adhurst St Mary, London Road, Sheet, Petersfield – Mr J Nolan.

Members received and noted notification from East Hampshire District Council of licensing applications up to 14th March 2011.

P 0672 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES

Members received and noted notification from Hampshire County Council of the following temporary road closures:-

a)

Road to be closed: That part of Tilmore Gardens between a point 105 metres south east of its junction with Monks Orchard and a point 85 metres south east thereof.

Alternative route: None (cul-de-sac)

Reason for closure: To allow Scotia Gas networks to lay new gas main and services.

Period of closure: From 6th April 2011 for a period of 3 months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. It is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 20 days.

- Road to be closed:** Kingsfersden Lane between 20m from each side of the level crossing.
- Alternative routes:** From western point of closure; north east via Long Lane to its junction with School Lane; east via School Lane to its junction with Farnham Road; south via Farnham Road/Inmans Lane to its junction with London Road (A272); west via London Road/Ramshill to its junction with Kingsfersden lane; north west via Kingsfersden Lane to eastern point of closure and vice versa.
- Reason for closure:** To allow network Rail to carry out essential maintenance works, on or adjacent to, Kingsfersden Lane, Petersfield level crossing.
- Period of closure:** From 3rd May 2011 for a period of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. It is expected that the closure will only be required occasionally overnight between 2000hrs and 0600hrs. The first overnight closures will be Tuesday 3rd May 2011 and Wednesday 4th May 2011.

TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTION

Members receive and noted notification from Hampshire County Council of the following 10mph speed restriction (convoy working):-

- Pulens Lane, Petersfield:** Between its junction with Durford Road and its junction with London Road.
- Period of restriction:** From 2nd April 2011 for a period of 6 months or until completion of the works whichever is the soonest. It is expected the restriction will be required for no longer than 2-3 days, likely to be in June. Advance warning signs will be displayed approximately 2 weeks in advance for any convoy working
